You may choose only the items you desire, **however, any funeral arrangement you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy an item you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

ADMINISTRATIVE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; shelter of remains; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g, cemetery, crematory and others as required. Obtain authorizations and permits and a fee necessary to cover a share of our overhead costs such as license, insurance, maintenance of facilities and equipment, utilities, and a host of other costs related to being in a business to serve public.

The fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.).....\$1,500.00

Transfer of decedent from place of death to our funeral home (within 50 mile radius, \$3.00 per mile after).....\$500.00
Second attendant for a residence removal (required).....\$200.00

PROFESSIONAL EMBALMING

[Except in certain special cases] embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing.. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose and arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. If embalming is declined and the final disposition of the deceased has not been finalized within 48 hrs of the time we have received the deceased into our care, refrigeration is required.

DIRECT CREMATION WITHOUT CEREMONY OR VIEWING.

If you want to arrange for a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering): The containers we provide are made of heavy cardboard. Direct cremations range from \$950.00 to \$1,150.00. IF decedent exceeds 250 pounds there is a \$5.00 fee per extra pound

Includes administrative and professional service of funeral director and staff; local transfer of decedent from place of death to our facility (within 50 mile radius); refrigeration, in lieu of embalming (maximum of 3 days) dressing if embalming is authorized; statistical processing of death certificate and burial permit; and local transportation to crematory. This charge does not include merchandise, formal viewing of remains or funeral ceremony.
